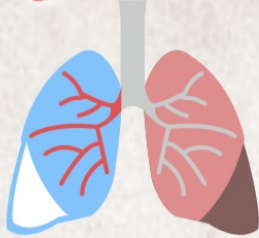


Hazard Communication Standard/GHS Compliance Timeline

All dates refer to GHS compliance in the USA.
For GHS regulations in other countries, please refer to local legislation.



June 1, 2015



All chemical manufacturers, importers, distributors and employers must be in compliance with all modified provisions of this final rule, except:

Distributors may ship products labeled by manufacturers under the old system until December 1, 2015.



June 1, 2016

All employers must update alternative workplace labeling and hazard communication program as necessary, and provide additional employee training for newly identified physical or health hazards.

2013

December 1, 2013

All employers must train employees on the new label elements and Safety Data Sheet (SDS) format.



2015

December 1, 2015

Chemical distributors may no longer ship products labeled by chemical manufacturers under the old HazCom Standard.

Transition Period

All chemical manufacturers, importers, distributors and employers must comply with either 29 CFR 1910.1200 (this final standard) or the current standard, or both.
